### END OF YEAR COMMITTEE REPORTS

**Audit Committee:** Jim Young and Bill Kennett reported we're in good shape (I think) in terms of financial accounting. Bill commended Jim Morgan, Bob Ralston, Bob Davidson, and Jack Higgins for the fine work they do. Some adjustment has been made to separate the Foundation accounting.

**Club News and Publicity:** Chair Don Winger said his committee will renew plans to launch a Kiwassee Kiwanis program on MCTV. Don said there is considerable potential for informative programs about Kiwassee Kiwanis, Kiwanis International, local Key Club activities, fund raising events, and the many contributions Kiwanis makes to our community.

**Fund Raising:** Jack Higgins reported that our fund raising programs generate about \$20,000 per year to support our community outreach activities. Travel and Adventure ticket sales (Jack Higgins) provide \$8,000 to \$9,000 from about \$18,000 in sales, and the Candy and Nut sales (Jim Rajewski) provide about \$9,000 based on sales of \$30,000. The new Golf Outing event (Pete Dzuris) contributed \$4,500. (Pete has recently left Midland. Renee Yates is considering chairing the golf event next year). The Kiwassee internet site (Jim Morgan) also provides funds from internet sales.

**Senior Youth:** Co-Chair Al Forster said his committee contributed \$4,450 to Key Clubs, MCFTA Outreach program, Salvation Army SHARE program, University of Wisconsin Whitewater Seminar, Camp Fish Tale, Chamber of Commerce Youth Leadership Program, and Windover support.

**Club Meetings:** Co-Chair Gene Woodward credited the members of his committee for their considerable work in making the meetings go smoothly. He also thanked Dave Sias (Interclubs), Don Winger (Pigmaster), and the several members who provide our music. Gene had one request: He asked members to PLEASE remember to fill out the attendance forms that are on the tables at each meeting.
